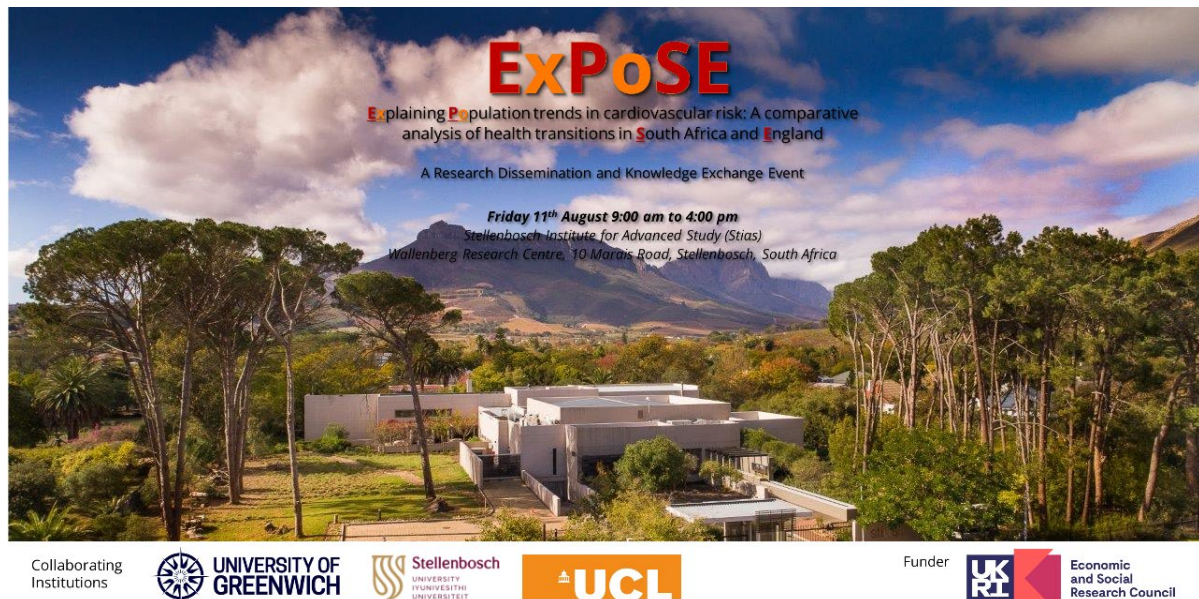


## Dissemination event: Explaining Population Trends in Cardiovascular Risk



The [Division of Health Systems and Public Health](#) at Stellenbosch University is organising a research dissemination and knowledge sharing event to launch the finding of the project, [Explaining Population Trends in Cardiovascular Risk: A Comparative Analysis of Health Transitions in South Africa and England \(ExPoSE\)](#).

The project, which is led by [Dr Kafui Adjaye-Gbewonyo](#) of the University of Greenwich and Dr [Annibale Cois](#) of Stellenbosch University uses nationally-representative population surveys to examine and explain trends in cardiovascular risk in South Africa and England from 1998 to 2017. The project is also producing a harmonised dataset, code and a data dashboard which will be made publicly available for other researchers and practitioners to use, and these will be showcased during the event.

The event will be held on the **11<sup>th</sup> of August** at the [Stellenbosch Institute for Advanced Study \(Stias\)](#) Wallenberg Research Centre, 10 Marais Road, Stellenbosch, South Africa, **from 9 AM to 4 PM**, and the possibility of remote participation (via Microsoft Teams) will also be provided.
